Praise Packs available at the entrances. Also, there are toys for younger children at the front of church

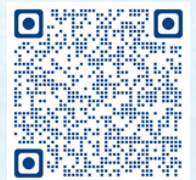

Recap of Last Week's Service - Respect – Resurrect: Lies Dehumanise, In Jesus We Rise

Last week's message from Ephesians 5:1–20 reminded us that God calls us to live as children of light, reflecting His love, truth, and goodness. Lies and sin draw us into darkness and diminish our humanity, but in Jesus we are resurrected into true life—fully human, fully alive, and radiant with His light.

We explored how dehumanising others leads to conflict and division, yet Christ restores dignity and hope. On this Remembrance Sunday, we reflected on those who sacrificed their lives for peace, and on the ultimate sacrifice of Jesus, whose death and resurrection bring light that no darkness can overcome.

Through stories of compassion and courage—from a stretcher-bearer who saved an enemy soldier to Jesus healing a paralysed man—we saw what it means to respect the image of God in every person and to help others rise.

As we prayed, we invited the Holy Spirit to awaken us from spiritual sleep, heal what is broken, and fill us with resurrection life so that we may shine God's light wherever we go.
